Eligibility Criteria

- Hold a Master's degree or be an engineer in a field related to Natural Sciences or Social Sciences.
- Alternatively, candidates with a higher education diploma may apply if they have at least three years of relevant professional or personal experience in artisanal mariculture.

📖 Study Requirements

- Theoretical and practical courses are conducted entirely in English- a high level of English proficiency is mandatory.
- Selected students will receive a scholarship allowance during their stay in Toliara. ***They must cover their own travel expenses to the training center in Toliara***, whether coming from Madagascar or abroad.
- However: **possibility to cover a return ticket (his country to Toliara) for best candidate.**
